

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VARIOUS ROADS, BRIDPORT AND WEST BAY FOR BRIDPORT TORCHLIGHT PARADE

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of the following roads in Bridport and West Bay (in both directions) by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles.

On Sunday 18 August 2019 as follows:

- Part South Street, from its junction with West Street to its junction with Gundry Lane - 20:00 to 22:30
- Part South Street, from its junction with Gundry Lane to its junction with West Bay Road - 20:45 to 22:30
- Part West Bay Road, from its junction with South Street to the Crown Roundabout - 20:45 to 22:30
- Part West Bay Road, from the Crown Roundabout to its junction with Station Road - 21:00 to 22:30
- Station Road in its entirety - 21:00 to 23:30

There will be no signed alternative route for diverted traffic on this occasion.
